The position is part-time, unpaid, has a flexible timeframe (5-15 hrs/week), and is based in La Crosse, WI. Occasional evening or weekend hours may be required.

- Assisting with marketing materials, social media and outreach for events
- Assisting with development and production of sponsor, volunteer, and participant materials
- Working with staff and volunteers on event day to insure the event's success
- Taking photos at events for the Conservancy to use in social media
- Assisting with procuring supplies for events
- Assisting with sponsorship and registration tracking
- Assisting with grant research and writing
- Other duties as assigned
